



Our future is bright

On March 20, 2020, the Beau-Rivage Palace closed its doors for the first time ever since its opening more than a century and a half earlier. Once the shock of the pandemic subsided, Nathalie Seiler-Hayez, the hotel's general manager realized this was a once-in-a-lifetime opportunity. "We have to close?" she said to the Board of Directors of Sandoz Foundation Hotels, "then let's reopen even more beautiful than ever!"


The long-discussed renovation of the hotel's original wing, known as Beau-Rivage, was set in motion almost immediately. And two years and five days later, on March 25, 2022, the historic Beau-Rivage wing reopened its doors.


In 2020, the Beau-Rivage Palace spa was also completely transformed into one of Europe's most exquisite sanctuaries of elegance, calm and wellbeing.

The Sandoz Family Foundation's dedication to the Beau-Rivage Palace has resulted in an even more gracious and magnificent facility on the storied shores of Lake Geneva. It honors its eternal motto: *La Tradition en Mouvement*.

The results are breathtaking.







The Hotel Beau-Rivage opened in 1861, and it was in 1908 that the Palace wing was opened. The two were seamlessly amalgamated by the creation of an elegant concourse leading to the Belle Epoque Sandoz and Rotonde ballrooms. The new combined Beau-Rivage Palace was inspired by hotel director Jacques Tschumi, whose legend was amplified by the founding of the adjacent Ecole Hôtelière de Lausanne (Lausanne Hotel School), to this day considered the world's most prestigious hotel school.

Opened on March 24, 1861, the Beau-Rivage immediately established itself as one of Europe's most privileged addresses, recognized for its exquisite location overlooking Lake Geneva and the French Alps and for the quality of its professional, warm and discreet service.

Which explains why every facet of our hotel is the result of dedicated creativity and a devotion to perfection.



A renovation promising *elegance, grace and sustainability.*

The 2020 reimagining of the Beau-Rivage wing was entrusted to Paris' Pierre-Yves Rochon architectural firm, responsible for the 2014 head-to-toe renovation of the Palace wing. The transformation of the historic Beau-Rivage wing was designed to bring it up to the exquisite level of the Palace wing, and was inspired and overseen by Nathalie Seiler-Hayez, one of Europe's handful of female general managers of five-star "palace" hotels.

Rochon's commission was straightforward:


- Maintain the spirit of an intimate and personal home-from-home, while offering the ability to combine suites and rooms into private modular units suitable for family and diplomatic gatherings.
- Preserve the architectural heritage, while guaranteeing high-performance and easy-to-use technology.
- Celebrate the unique natural setting at the same time limiting the project's ecological impact.


Cultivating the spirit of an intimate and personal home...


Unlike modern hotels, every room in a 160-year-old edifice is different. It's an unusual and stimulating goal for a designer to tailor-make layout, furniture – antique and new, parquet flooring, carpets, rugs, curtains. Just one tiny factoid: 1.4 kilometers of fabric went into drapes and upholstery in the new Beau-Rivage wing.

On the walls are original works of art and historical prints, lithographs and eclectica, as well as period mirrors selected from within the hotel and its storage facilities, and restored by some of Lausanne's finest artisans.

The bathrooms are large and bright, many with windows and French doors, and sublime white marble. Each bathroom was designed to provide the latest techniques and conveniences. In the suites, the faucet knobs, each different, were hand made by Maison Baccarat.







...Offering freeform modularity.


One of the unique features of the Beau-Rivage wing is the modularity of spaces. This enables us to customize multi-suites of bedrooms, living rooms, and dining rooms – ideally suited for large families, or diplomatic entourages.

Preserve the architectural heritage, while guaranteeing high-performance technological services.

The Beau-Rivage wing comprises 63 rooms and 7 suites. Each room and suite has been equipped with state-of-the-art, yet easily operated controls and connectivity.

This manages the temperature and the intensity of the light according to the time of day and the seasons, allowing meaningful energy savings.

Guests can also connect their personal devices to the room's private network. On request, content can be loaded into the media area before you even arrive.



Celebrating the exquisite natural setting... limiting the ecological impact...

The Beau-Rivage Palace's ten-acre park is an unprecedented treasure on the shores of Lake Geneva. And yet the center of Lausanne is a mere 15-minute stroll away.

Pierre-Yves Rochon developed a color palette for the new Beau-Rivage wing, reflecting the exact tones of the sky and the lake, from the park's masses of year-round flowers and centuries-old trees. All materials used – from paint to carpets – are ecologically safe and free of harmful chemicals..

Insulation of the roof and windows has been reinforced to reduce both noise and energy loss. Instead of energy-intensive air conditioning, we're cooled by a unique system that pumps water from Lake Geneva.

Finally, the suppliers and artisans who worked on this historic site are all from local companies, furthering our support of the local economy.








A palace hotel is judged by the splendor of its suites...

The historic suites of our Beau-Rivage wing are iconic. We have retained the names they were given 160 years ago. The renovation has carefully and respectfully augmented their glamour, their practicality, their sense of the sublime.





THE IMPERIAL SUITE


The most beautiful view of Lausanne.

The Imperial Suite embodies the characteristic styles of the mid-19th-century's "Second Empire" style, stressing straight lines and symmetry.

Couches, beds, chairs are detailed with finely chiseled bronzes inspired by the civilizations of ancient Egypt, Greece and Rome. Each aspect of the Imperial Suite is unique, and the result of the finest, museum-quality craftsmanship.

The Imperial Suite has the largest terrace of any hotel room in Lausanne. Its 120 sq. meters (1,300 sq. feet) is a private "garden." And with its custom-made furniture, giant bonsais, lush plants, and an unobstructed view of the park, the lake, the Alps, it is ideal for sunning, relaxing and *al fresco* dining.

In addition to bedrooms, drawing room and bathrooms, The Imperial Suite has a private office.




THE ROYAL SUITE

The exquisite refinement of a residence on the shores of Lake Geneva.

The splendor of the Second Empire style, fashionable throughout Europe when the hotel opened, is reflected in The Royal Suite's rich assortment of antiques, fireplaces, mirrors, candelabras and chandeliers. There are references to the universe of Versailles' Queen Marie-Antoinette, so admired by France's Empress Eugénie. The Royal Suite's Venetian-mirrored dressing room is one of the hotel's prettiest.

The Royal Suite offers delicacy, atmosphere and softness. The color palate evokes the subtle rose of dawn, when sky and lake merge majestically. The view from its balcony is blissful, hypnotizing guests with its panorama of park, lake and mountains.



THE MALMAISON SUITE


The pinnacle of the Beau-Rivage Palace.

The Malmaison Suite is the preferred suite of Royalty, heads of state and diplomats.

Inspired by the magnificent Château de Malmaison remodeled by Empress Joséphine in 1806, this exceptional suite is an artful combination of the formal with the subtle. Its design is ideal not only for relaxation but also for conducting the weighty affairs of state.

It is a true haven of peace, of unimaginable elegance. Its balcony faces Lake Geneva and the Alps. It is a suite that provides confidentiality, calm and inspiration.

Particularly suited to large families and diplomatic delegations, the Malmaison Suite can be combined with neighboring guest-rooms and suites into a vast and secure private complex.




THE ART DECO SUITE

The Art Deco Suite exudes a majestic calm. Located on the top floor of the Beau-Rivage wing, this suite can be custom configured with the neighboring Riviera Suite to create a 232 sq. meter (2,500 sq. feet) private apartment for as many as ten guests. With its extraordinary lake view from all rooms, this is yet another unique Beau-Rivage gem.


THE RIVIERA SUITE

The elegant art of living.

The Riviera Suite, located at the southwest corner of the Beau-Rivage wing, is a place where the shadows of our historic trees play with the light that bathes the walls, the mirrors and the ceiling. It can be custom configured with the neighboring Art Deco Suite to create a 232 sq. meter (2,500 sq. feet) private apartment for as many as ten guests.

The ultimate elegance of this suite is the art and taste of the Belle Epoque. Each pattern, each color, finds its origin in the decoration which comes through the windows from our park, from Lake Geneva, from the Alps.

The blond parquet floor adds a gesture of the present day. The bar dominates the drawing room and is secreted within a gilded armoire inspired by Asian plant motifs. Like every suite at the Beau-Rivage Palace, the Riviera Suite has its own signature sense of style.



THE PANORAMIC SUITE


The Beau- Rivage Palace is a slice of hotel cinema.




It is accessible by elevator directly from the guest room floors, so you will feel comfortable in just a robe and slippers.


The 2020 transformation of the Beau-Rivage Palace's Cinq Mondes spa bears the signature of Suprem Architectures' Alexandre Pierart who has devised a calming journey into the mysterious, the abstract, the tranquil. His poetic vision of space, materials and light encourages introspection and rejuvenation.

Pierart has expressed the soft curves of nature in stone, oak, gold, water, warm and subdued lighting. His meditative journey climaxes at a majestic interior "tree", with its undulating flame. This spiritual dimension promotes relaxation, comfort and a sense of wellbeing.

The 1,500 sq. meter (16,000 sq. feet) Cinq Mondes spa has eight treatment rooms, as well as an opulent Japanese-style private double suite with its own private garden. The fitness room and the yoga and meditation studio face the gardens. The spa has direct access to the Beau-Rivage Palace's indoor heated swimming pool and Jacuzzi, and to the outdoor patio, gardens and heated outdoor pool.

The spa's saunas and hammams have been completely refreshed and redesigned, with "experience showers," and ice cellar and ice fountain.

- The Lausanne architects
 Achille de la Harpe and
 Jean-Baptiste Bertolini
 are entrusted with the
 Beau-Rivage project in
 the "Ouchy Quayside
 Redevelopment Plan."
- On March 24: the Hotel Beau-Rivage open its doors, under the management of Monsieur Alexander Rufenacht.
- The Beau-Rivage is the first hotel in Ouchy to be mentioned in a tourist guide, Les Guides Joanne Hôt:
 "The Beau-Rivage, one of the largest, most beautiful, best located, and best maintained in all of Switzerland."
 (Joanne, 1865, p.85)
- The Lausanne-Ouchy Funicular is inaugurated, directly connecting the lakeside to Lausanne's railway station, now significant developed with the establishment of lines to Valais, Bern, and finally Paris.
- Jacques Tschumi becomes general manager of the Hotel Beau-Rivage.



- Jacques Tschumi opens the Ecole Hôtelière de Lausanne (Lausanne Hotel School), in the 21st-century still considered the world's finest.
- On June 19, the Palace wing opens, the work of the architect Eugène Jost, in Belle Epoque style.
 The Beau-Rivage becomes the Beau-Rivage Palace.
- Negotiated at the Beau-Rivage Palace, the Treaty of Ouchy is signed, ending the Italo-Turkish conflict.
- Hosting of the conference of the Treaty of Lausanne, drawing the borders of present-day Turkey.
- Gabrielle Coco Chanel moves in permanently to the Beau-Rivage Palace. Some years later she acquires a villa on the heights of Lausanne.

- Charlie Chaplin and his wife
 Oona settle in Switzerland and
 spend their first night in the
 country at the Beau-Rivage
 Palace.
- Edouard-Marcel Sandoz creates the Family Foundation Sandoz, now the majority shareholder of Beau-Rivage Palace SA.
- Albert Cohen publishes his novel Belle du Seigneur, inspired by the romantic atmosphere of the Beau-Rivage Palace.
- Opening of the hotel's first spa, which later became the Spa Cing Mondes.
- Opening of the Anne-Sophie Pic restaurant at the Beau-Rivage Palace headed by Anne-Sophie Pic, one of France's few female chefs to earn three Michelin stars.
 The Michelin guide awards two stars to the restaurant.



- Renovation of the rooms in the Palace wing. The new decor is entrusted to the Parisian architect Pierre-Yves Rochon who, through the play of mirrors, brings the lake into the rooms.
- Nathalie Seiler-Hayez is appointed general manager of the Beau-Rivage Palace.
- Creation of Sandoz Foundation
 Hotels, a collection bringing
 together six exceptional
 Swiss hotels, including the
 Beau-Rivage Palace.
- Transformation of the Cinq Mondes Spa.
- Renovations of the bedrooms in the Beau-Rivage wing again entrusted to the architectdesigner Pierre-Yves Rochon, equalizing the splendor and the luxury of the Beau-Rivage and the Palace wings.




