The Guerlain Spa is attached to the hotel's heated indoor swimming pool that leads to the outdoor swimming pool, with its unique sandy Ouchy Beach.

The House of Guerlain, with its vaunted perfumes and beauty products, has brought its exquisite aesthetic to a mélange of luxury hotels such as the Breakers in Palm Beach, the Hotel du Palais in Biarritz, the Baie des Flammands in St. Barths, and the Waldorf Astorias in Amsterdam and Jerusalem.

The Beau-Rivage Palace Spa, completely refashioned in 2020 by architect Alexandre Pierart, is readying to welcome the House of Guerlain with its legendary treatments and sense of chic that underscores the wellbeing of the soul and the body.

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
